Minutes of the meeting dated 28.08.2020 of the High-Powered Committee under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Kumari Justice Sanju Panda, Judge, Orissa High Court and Executive Chairperson, Odisha State Legal Services Authority with regard to release of prisoners for decongestion of jails in view of spreading of Covid-19 disease, over telephonic conversation.

The twenty second meeting of HPC is convened through telephonic conversation by the following dignitaries-

- > DLSA, Dhenkanal submitted a report vide L. No. 974 dated 26.08.2020 regarding 03 nos. of Part-Time Medical Officer to be found as COVID positive on 25.08.2020. The Collector, Dhenkanal has been apprised to depute one Doctor to District Jail, Dhenkanal in order to attend the jail hospital for necessary treatment.
- DLSA, Sambalpur submitted a report vide proceeding of the meeting of UTRC, Sambalpur held on 26.08.2020 stating that the Superintendent, Circle Jail, Sambalpur vide his L No. 5038 dated 26.08.2020 reported that 11 nos. of staff were found COVID- 19 positive. The Collector-cum-District Magistrate, Sambalpur is requested to take immediate steps for complete and full sanitization of the premises of Circle Jail, Sambalpur, Further, he has been instructed to keep the 11 nos. of staff in isolation so as to restrain them from coming in contact with other inmates.
- DLSA, Jagatsinghpur vide L. No. 841 dated 28.08.2020 submitted a report vide minutes of the resolution dated 28.08.2020 of UTRC, Jagatsinghpur intimated regarding detection of Chief-Warder of Sub-Jail, Jagatsinghpur, Sri Ashok Kumar Swain as COVID positive. As per the advice of the CDMO, Jagatsinghpur, he has been immediately isolated and he has been put under treatment and home isolation.

The CDM & PHO, Dhenkanal vide L. No. 2837 dated 27.08.20 to the Under Secretary to Government, Health & Family Welfare Department has communicated regarding identification of 66 nos. of inmates of District Jail, Dhenkanal as COVID positive under intimation to the Member Secretary, OSLSA.

S.O.P on Protocol of remand by Department of Home, Govt. of Odisha

In reply to the report called from the Principal Secretary regarding identification of large number of jail inmates being found as COVID positive, the Special Secretary to Government, Home Department, Government of Odisha placed before the Hon'ble Chairperson, High Powered Committee the communication made vide L. No. 28624/JAILS, Bhubaneswar dated 28.08.2020 to the Addl. Chief Secretary, H&FW Department/the DG & IG of Police, Odisha, Cuttack/the DG of Prisons & DCS, Odisha, Bhubaneswar regarding the standard operating procedure (SOP) for implementing the protocol of remand to be followed regarding lodging of newly arrested accused persons in jails. Accordingly, the SOP containing 8 guidelines have been placed before the HPC as follows:

- Any person to be produced before Magistrate for remand by the Police/Excise/Forest/Vigilance authorities etc. shall first be screened/tested by Medical Officers for COVID- 19 along with the mandatory medical examination in a designated hospital.
- Medical Officer of the designated hospital shall conduct thorough examination of those persons proposed to be remanded to jails and shall record that the person is asymptomatic or symptomatic to COVID-19.
- 3. Anybody found positive in this process, should be sent to the "Dedicated Covid Care Center/Dedicated Covid Health Center/Dedicated Covid Hospital" by the concerned remanding agencies like Police, Forest, Excise or Vigilance as the case may be for treatment with the permission of remanding courts. They will be shifted to the jails after being recovered in "Dedicated Covid

- Care Center/Dedicated Covid Health Center/Dedicated Covid Hospital".
- 4. Only those asymptomatic accused persons (to be declared by the Medical Officer of the designated hospital), shall be remanded to jails after being tested with Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and found "Negative".
- 5. All newly remanded persons having Covid- 19 negative reports shall be kept in prisons in isolation wards/quarantine wards in concerned District Jails/Sub-Jails within same Revenue District (in case of overcrowding of any particular jail).
- 6. CDMOs of concerned districts will depute medical staff for random tests of prisoners at designated places (to be decided by District Administration) for which SsP/DCPs shall provide Police escort. In case any prisoner is detected as Covid positive, same prisoner shall be shifted to Dedicated Covid Care Center/Dedicated Covid Health Center/Dedicated Covid Hospital forthwith for which local police shall provide police escort.
- To avoid infection due to physical production, technology-based virtual production from jails may be considered with concerned courts.
- 8. If a Covid positive patient is required to be admitted in the Covid facility, one escort shall be allowed to remain in the Covid Facility for safe custody of the prisoner as is done for non-covid prisoners. Such escort may be allowed to use PPE. After the discharge of the prisoner, the escort shall be quarantined for 14 days, either in home isolation (if separate room with attached toilet and a care giver is available) or may be kept in a Covid Care Center. Covid-19 Test shall be done on 14th day of isolation or quarantine.

On perusal of the SOP on protocol of remand to jails regarding newly arrested accused persons issued by Department of Home, Govt. of Odisha, the HPC resolves to direct the Additional Chief Secretary, Health & FW, Govt. of Odisha to ensure that this protocol is scrupulously followed. Further, it is directed that Member Secretary, OSLSA shall place a report on compliance of this SOP in the jails before the HPC.

As there has been a steep rise in COVID- 19 positive cases in many jails in the State, HPC also reiterates that all stakeholders make utmost efforts to arrest the spread of pandemic, before the situation assumes an alarming proportion.
