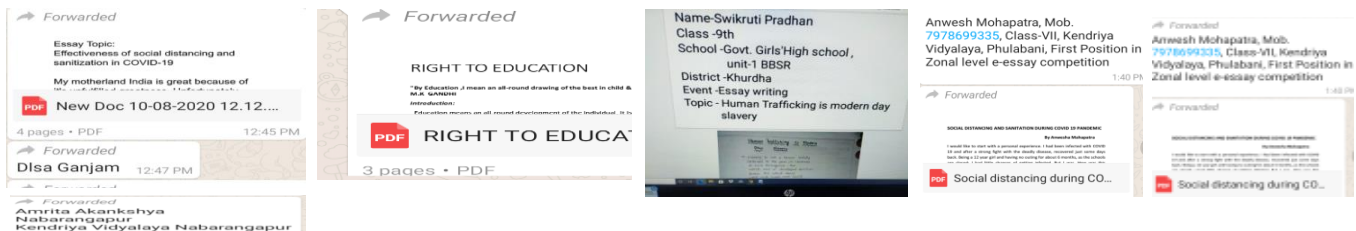

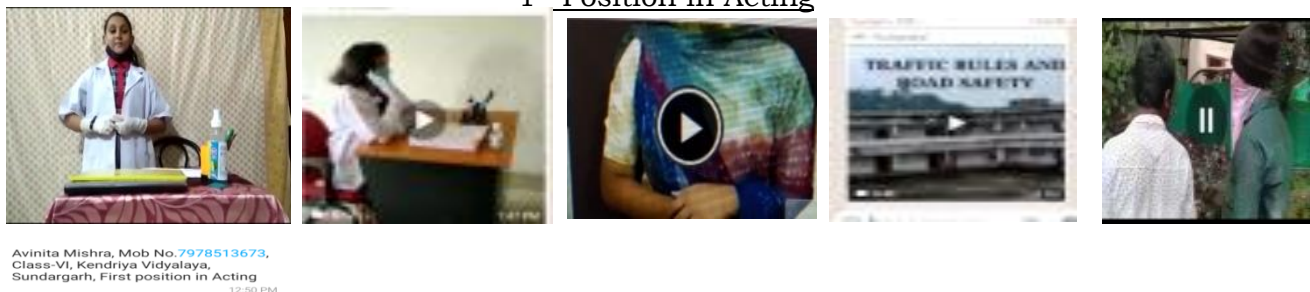
1st Position in Painting
