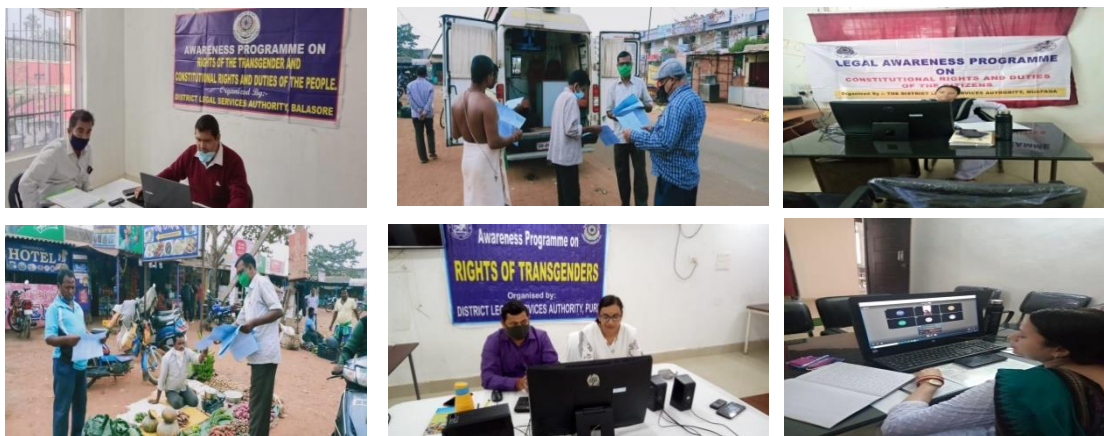

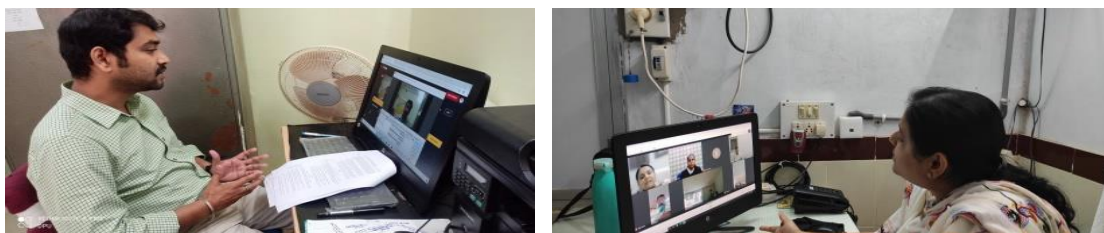

**SUCCESS STORY**

**Legal Assistance to KuntalaAunty and two minor Girl Children.**

One KuntalaBehera, age about 40 years, W/o- Krushna Chandra Behera, At- Gundichapada, Ps- Sadar, Dist- Dhenkanal filed an application in this Office, stating that her husband has deserted her three years back and she does not know the whereabouts of her husband. In this premises, she requested to take necessary action for maintenance and education of her two minor girl children who are aged about 08 years and 05 years old respectively.

In the above circumstances, the Secretary, DLSA, Dhenkanal immediately in consultation with the District Judge-cum-Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Dhenkanal instructed the District Social Welfare Officer, Dhenkanal to make necessary arrangements to rehabilitate the women and her two minor girl children in a proper shelter home in Dhenkanal as per the Government rules and guidelines. Then, the women as well as her two minor Children were sent to Nysadri Shelter Home, Santhasara, Dhenkanal for their care and protection.
