### **During the period 1<sup>st</sup> OCTOBER to 31<sup>st</sup> OCTOBER 2022**

The Odisha State Legal Services Authority is adapting innovative methods and using social media tools & technology to make the legal system robust and to ensure fair and meaningful justice to the marginalized and poor sections of the society. It has undertaken different trainings programmes both in physical and virtual mode. One-click connectivity to the Legal Aid Clinics, different DLSA and TLSC from Nyaya Sanjog continue to be available. **Around 155 nos.** of Legal awareness programmes/webinars in Odisha were conducted by using both Social & Digital mode, i.e. new tools like Jitsi Meet, YouTube live, Google Meet etc., OSLSA continues motivating its field units to strive hard in rendering legal services through effective means to serve the common mass and work for their betterment.

## SUCCESS STORY



1. Smt. Malati Ghadia, D/o Late Nanda kishore Ghadia, Vill-Birabrahmapur of Balesore District on her grievance petition addressed to Hon'ble High court, that she is a disabled, cancer patient and landless woman who deprived from social security benefits from the Government and made allegation against the BDO. As per the direction of Hon'ble High court of Orissa, This Authority noted on her grievance petition and directs the concerned DLSA to enquire about the allegation made by the petitioner and the Collector -cum -District Magistrate, Balesore requested to devote their personal attention for the petitioner's grievance. Accordingly, the Civil Supplies Officer, Balasore vide letter no-1994/11.10.2022 has submitted the action taken report in respect of OSLSA, and intimated that "The matter of Smt. Malati Ghadia, Petitioner was enquired by the Inspector of Supplies, Simulia and AAY Ration Card bearing No02111010178 has been issued to Smt. Malati Ghadia and also been provided 35 k.g of rice for the month of August & September, 2022".
2. On receiving information, from daily Newspaper the Sambad dated 14.09.2022 under the caption "**Pancha Masha Hela Bhatta Ru Banchita Moti Kumbhar**" where it is reported that an old woman namely **Moti Kumbhar** of village Khatiguda Parajabarang Padar Panchayat under Tentulikhunti Block, who was deprived to get the benefit of old age pension from last five months. The matter was put up before the chairman DLSA Nabarangpur for taking immediate action. The matter was intimated to the collector Nabarangpur with a direction to the secretary DLSA, Nabarangpur for taking immediate action. The matter was intimated to the collector Nabarangpur vide this office letter No.1204/14.09.2022 with a copy to Block Development Officer and DSSO Nabarangpur with a request to extend all possible steps and compliance report may be intimated at the earliest. Soon after the intervention of DLSA Nabarangpur the old woman has got old age pension of last five months on 16.09.2022.
3. Smt. Subhransu Dash who filed a grievance petition against her husband regarding her family dispute which registered under Pre-litigation dispute having PLA No-28/2022 on dated 17.06.2022, The matter was put up before the Judge, P&CLA(Nabarangpur) for redressal of the grievance. Notice was issued to the Opposite party by both ways for his appearance and conciliation. On dated 17<sup>th</sup> June, 8<sup>th</sup> August, 8<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022 both the parties appeared before the judge for conciliation process. Having proceeded through conciliation, they both agreed to settle their dispute amicably and intimated the same line in writing to this Authority and are leading their happy conjugal life.

## Facilitating the Students to have the basic knowledge on Legal Services

Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High court of Orissa and Patron-in-Chief Odisha State Legal Services Authority, Cuttack has been pleased to initiate a programme since the Children's Day 2021 for the visit of the students of different educational institutions to the High court of Orissa, Odisha State Legal Services Authority and Judicial Academy on different holidays to make them aware of those institutions.
