On 15. 11.2023 Secretary, DLSA got to know about the trembling issue from the Odia Daily Newspaper The Prameya" regarding the death of a couple namely Gokul Chandra Sahoo and his wife Anindita Subudhi of Benagadiapatna, Bolgarh leaving behind two daughter Akankhya Sahoo aged 12 years and Anwesha Sahoo aged 7 years. Thereafter on 16.11.2023 Secretary DLSA Khurda visited the House of deceased person and interacted with teir family members.

Subsequent thereto, the DCPO was directed to take steps as per their requirement keeping in view as paramount of the children. The DCPO thereafter took up the matter and extended the benefit of Rs.4,000/- per month for each of the child under the Scheme namely "Mission Vastalya" which would meet the expenditure incurred towards their health, education and nutrition.
